

Musqueam Monday Golf Tour 2025 (MMGT)

A Flexible and Fun Competition

Organized by Musqueam Golf Learning Academy, Vancouver

Concept:

This league is to offer a customized and flexible tournament experience. Players can compete every Monday between 8:00 am and 4:00 pm without a fixed schedule. Here is what makes this format unique:

- **Play Your Way:** Players can choose their preferred tee time, book in advance, and play with friends or be paired with other participants.
- **No Pressure:** Enjoy a relaxed round of golf with friends while still competing for prizes. It feels like a regular golf outing, but with the added excitement of being part of a tournament.
- **Flexibility:** The Monday-only format accommodates busy schedules, making it easy for players to balance work, life, and golf while enjoying a competitive atmosphere.

How It Works

- **Book a tee time:** Choose any time between **8:00 am and 4:00 pm** on Mondays.
- **Play your round:** Show up and enjoy your game, either with friends or new players.
- **Sign your scorecard:** Make sure two players from your group sign it.
- **Return the scorecard:** Drop it off at the pro shop or with the starter after your round.
- **Check the leaderboard:** Track your progress every week.
- **After 10 rounds:** Your final position will be posted, showing how you have done.

It's easy, flexible, and fun! Meet new people, compete for prizes, and improve your game—without the pressure of a fixed schedule.

Eligibility

- Open to all men aged 21 and older.
 - **Eligibility Restriction:** This league is designed for recreational golfers. **Golf professionals** are not eligible to participate. This ensures a level playing field and a more enjoyable experience for all participants.

Season Dates

- **Start Date:** Monday, April 21, 2025.
 - **End Date:** Monday, June 23, 2025.
 - **Location:** Musqueam Golf Learning Academy, Vancouver.
 - **Rounds:** 10 rounds total.
 - **Tee Times:** Flexible tee times available from **8:00 am to 4:00 pm** every Monday.

League Structure

The league spans 10 weeks with weekly rounds and opportunities for individual competition. Here is the **week-by-week schedule**:

Game Format

- **Single Category:** All participants compete in the same division.
- **All Rounds:** Individual Stroke Play.
- **Scoring:** FedEx-style points system, where points are awarded based on placement in each round.
 - No playoffs—ranking is determined solely by accumulated points.

Tee Boxes

- All players will tee off from the **blue markers**.

Scoring System

- Points awarded per round based on placement:
 - **1st:** 10 points
 - **2nd:** 9 points
 - **3rd:** 8 points
 - **4th:** 7 points

- **5th:** 6 points
 - **6th-10th:** 5 points
 - **11th-15th:** 3 points
 - **Participation:** 1 point (for all players who complete the round).
-

Tie-Breaking Procedure

In the event of a tie at the end of the league (after all 10 rounds), the following steps will be applied:

1. **Best Single Round Score:** The player with the lowest single round score from the entire season is ranked higher.
 2. **Best Final Round Score:** If still tied, the player with the lowest score in the final round (June 23) takes the higher position.
 3. **Head-to-Head Match Play:** If the tie remains unresolved, a **head-to-head 18-hole match** will be played to determine final rankings.

Weekly Contests

- **Closest-to-the-Pin** (2 contests per round: 1 on the front nine, 1 on the back nine).
- **Long Drive** (1 contest per round, alternating between front and back nine).
- **Bonus Points:** Winners of each contest earn **2 bonus points**.

Weekly Contests:

- Winners of the Closest-to-the-Pin and Long Drive contests each week will earn extra points (2 points per contest).
 - At the end of the 10 rounds, the player who has won the most Closest-to-the-Pin contests and the player who has won the most Long Drive contests will each receive the Special Recognition Prize.

Hole-in-One Policy

If a player makes a hole-in-one during the Musqueam Monday Golf Tour, the following conditions and rewards will apply:

1. Verification:
 - The hole-in-one must be witnessed by all players in the group.
 - The scorecard must be signed by at least two players from the group to confirm the achievement.
2. Eligibility for Prizes:
 - The player will receive a Special Recognition Certificate to commemorate the achievement.
 - Depending on sponsorships or available funds, the player may also receive an additional prize (e.g., gift card or golf merchandise).
3. Exclusions:
 - Hole-in-one achievements made during warm-up, practice rounds, or outside of the league's official rounds will not be eligible for recognition or prizes.
4. Tournament Rules:

- The hole-in-one must occur during official tournament play under the league's rules. Any breach of the rules, such as mulligans or practice swings, will invalidate the achievement.

Prizes and Recognition

- **Top 3 Players:** The players with the highest point totals at the end of the 10 rounds will be recognized.
 - **1st Place:** Gift Card (\$500 value) + Trophy
 - **2nd Place:** Gift Card (\$350 value) + Trophy
 - **3rd Place:** Gift Card (\$250 value) + Trophy
- **Special Recognition:**
 - **Closest to the Pin Winner:** TaylorMade Golf Kit (Hat, Glove, TP5 Golf Box)
 - **Long Drive Winner:** TaylorMade Golf Kit (Hat, Glove, TP5 Golf Box)
- **Hole-in-One Achievements:** Special Recognition Certificate + potential prizes.

Award Ceremony

The league will conclude with a special award ceremony and dinner on **Monday, June 30, 2025**, held at the Musqueam Golf Learning Academy. This event will celebrate the league's top performers, recognize contest winners, and highlight memorable moments from the season. Details about the event will be sent via email and posted on our website at www.musqueamgolf.com.

Rules and Guidelines

- All players will follow **Golf Canada rules**.
- **Maximum score per hole:** Triple bogey (to maintain pace of play).
- Your **scorecard must be signed** by two players from your foursome, whether public players or tournament participants, to be valid and earn points. Unsigned scorecards will not count. It is the player's responsibility to ensure the scorecard is signed and submitted correctly.
- Single rounds are not allowed; scorecards from single players will not count.
- **Non-Finishers:** No points will be awarded for rounds not completed unless a valid reason is provided.
- **Cancellations/Rescheduling:** Not allowed for earning points. **No rain checks permitted.** If a player does not show up, no points will be awarded.
- Local rules may apply.
- Code of conduct may apply.

Tournament Handicap Rule

1. Maximum Handicap:
 - The maximum allowable handicap for players in this tournament is 18.
2. Stroke Allocation:
 - Players will receive 1 stroke per hole, based on their handicap.
 - If a player has a handicap of 18, they will receive 1 stroke on every hole.

- If a player has a handicap of 12, they will receive 1 stroke on the 12 holes with the lowest handicap index, as designated on the scorecard.
3. Hole Stroke Order:
- Strokes will be assigned following the handicap ranking on the scorecard (e.g., holes labeled as 1, 2, 3, etc., receive strokes first).
4. Example:
- A player with a handicap of 15 will receive strokes on the 15 holes with the lowest handicap indexes, leaving 3 holes without strokes.
5. Additional Notes:
- Players with handicaps lower than 18 will still compete under this system, with strokes assigned accordingly.
 - No player can receive more than 1 stroke per hole.

Tee Time Booking Process

- **Booking Your Tee Time:** Call the pro shop at **604-266-2334** to book your tee time.
 - **Availability:** Tee times can be booked up to **2 weeks in advance**.
 - **Guaranteed Tee Times (only for threesomes and foursomes):** For an additional one-time fee of **\$20.00** per person, you can guarantee a reserved tee time between 8:00 am and 4:00 pm. This ensures your spot, allowing you to play with fellow league members.

Pairings and Grouping

- **Flexible Pairings:** Book with friends or meet new players by being paired randomly.
 - **Public Course:** As Musqueam Golf Learning Academy is a public course, tee times will be shared with non-league players. We encourage you to be flexible with pairings, but we also strive to create a dynamic and competitive atmosphere among league members.

Check-In on Game Day

- **Arrive Early:** Check in at the pro shop **at least 15 minutes** before your tee time.
 - **Equipment:** Remember, players must bring their own golf clubs. Sharing clubs is not allowed.
-

Important Notes

- **Missed Registration Deadlines:** Late entries may not be accepted, so register promptly.
 - **Tee Time Changes:** Notify the league coordinator immediately if you can't make your booked tee time.
 - **Communication:** You will receive weekly updates, reminders, and leaderboards via email. Additionally, all information will be available on the **Musqueam Monday Golf Tour 2025 (MMGT 2025)** Facebook page and our website at www.musqueamgolf.com.

Fee and Registration Conditions

League Registration Fee:

- Cost: \$100.00 per player. Plus, taxes.

What's Included:

Participation Limit:

- The tournament is limited to 72 players
 - If the league does not reach a minimum of **45 registered players**, all registration fees will be refunded in full.

Refund Policy:

1. If the League is Canceled Due to Low Participation:
 - Players will receive a 100% refund of their \$100 registration fee.
 2. Player-Initiated Withdrawal:
 - Withdrawals made before April 7, 2025, will receive a 75% refund (\$75).
 - Withdrawals made on or after April 7, 2025, are non-refundable.
 3. Missed Rounds:
 - Registration fees will not be refunded for missed rounds.
